**Big Brothers Big Sisters of Metropolitan Chicago** is recruiting girls between the ages of 7 to 14 for their Girls Mentoring program. Each young girl in the program is matched with an adult female mentor known as a Big Sister, for a minimum of 1 year. The match is expected to go on outings 2 to 4 times a month. The Big Sister picks up the Little Sister from their home and takes them on outings that will impact the Little Sister in three areas: Educational Achievement, Attitudes and Competencies and Avoidance of Risk Taking Behavior.

Throughout the year, the agency will host events that will introduce your child to various educational, career, and overall fun activities.

Some of the activities that matches can enjoy on their own include: visiting the zoo, taking a yoga class together, trying a new food, sight-seeing in down town, learning a new craft, playing in the park, visiting a college campus, talking about appropriate friendships, discussing prospective careers... the possibilities are endless!
